

Annual General Meeting 2022 & 2023 Race Info

The Annual General Meeting for 2022 took place on Sunday 13th November at South Newton Village Hall in Salisbury.

AGM

The minutes of the 2021 AGM were read and accepted as a true record and the Balance sheet was accepted.

The result of the ballot was as follows: 65 papers returned 4 not counted as 2 were not signed and 2 had resigned.

Propositions Number 1, Number 2 & Number 3 were all to open up the Classic radius. All 3 propositions failed as follows.

Proposition 1: 8 For 48 Against

Proposition 2: 11 For 48 Against

Proposition 3: 8 For 49 Against

Proposition Number 4: (Club General Rule 2). The object of the Club is the organisation of Classic racing. Passed. 51 For 7 Against.

Proposition Number 5: (Racing Rule 11b). Should the verification be outside the 60 minutes as prescribed in Rule 11a then the time the verification is made may be used as the clocking/ arrival time. Passed. **35 For 21 Against.**

Proposition Number 6: (Appendix A Item 3). 3. Clocks, with the exception of puncture clocks need not be checked/ opened on the day of clocking if the time of clocking is after 18.30hrs, but should be as soon as practical the following day. Passed. **40 For 16 Against.**

There were 83 resignations in 2022 which were accepted with regret.
