#### Channel Racing Paperwork

You must bring to the marking station with you on every occasion (except Guernsey) the following.

- 1. A copy of your CPH Certificate with your CPH registration number on it.
- 2. Your completed Racing Pigeon Establishment Operator's Declaration Form, signed and dated for 2024.
- 3. Your Vet's Attestation to prove that you have had your annual Vet Visit for 2024 racing.
- 4. Your vaccination form with every pigeon recorded on it which is housed on your premises for 2024.
